- **GWK Cultural Park(GWK Cultural Park is home to some of the most Iconic cultural landmarks in Bali, including the magnificent Garuda Wisnu Kencana Statue, which stands tall at 121 meters and is a representation of the Hindu God Vishnu and his mount, the Garuda Bird.)**

- **Turtle Island**

**Interacting with Turtle at the Turtle conservation center.**

- Uluwatu Cliff Temple

(The Balinese Hindus believe that the powers of the Hindu Trinity — Brahma, Vishnu, and Siva — merge here. That belief results in making Uluwatu Temple a place of worship of Siva Rudra, the Balinese Hindu deity of all elements and aspects of life in the universe.

**Kecak Dance**

Must see Arts Performance in Uluwatu Temple Bali. One of its highlights is the Kecak and Fire Dance Show that takes place at Sunset time. As you enjoy the sublime sunset, watch the locals put on a mesmerizing show of traditional and hypnotic Kecak Dance with swirling flames and vibrant cultural costumes. The show is perfectly timed for this. There is no doubt that it will be a memorable moment in the island.

- Rice Terrace (Entrance to Bali Swing has to pay separately )

- Kintamani Mount Batur

( The Kintamani Volcano is an active volcano and a very popular trek. The captivating Mount Batur surrounds the 13-sq-km Batur caldera lake.)

- Lunch
- Coffee Plantation
- Tampak Siring Holly Spring Temple

(Tirta Empul Temple is built around the Sacred Spring at Tampak Siring. For more than a thousand years, Balinese worshipers have been drawn to Tirta Empul Temple whose sacred spring is said to have been created by Lord Indra and have curative properties.)

- Dinner and stay at Hotel

## Day 5

After Breakfast we visit

- Tanah lot Temple

(Tanah Lot temple was built to worship Bhatara Segara, or the sea God. To protect the temple, with his mighty power, he created a poisonous snake from his sash.)

- Indian lunch
- Ulundanu Beratan Temple

(Pura Ulun Danu Beratan Temple was built in 17th century and is dedicated to the Hindu Gods Brahma, Vishnu and Shiva as well as the goddess of the lake, Dewi Danu. The name of the temple means the power or Source Temple of Lake Beratan.)

- Indian Dinner and stay at Hotel
